

Wrapper

Medium Cotton cloth

Description

Woman's wrapper woven on a man's horizontal loom in strips of

approximately 4.125" width; fifteen strips are sewn together edge to edge to form this wrapper. Aso-oke cloth in which a pattern is formed with two maroon strips, followed by one maroon/white/tan strip, followed in turn by two tan strips. This pattern is repeated three times. All of the strips contain open workholes accented by white weft threads. Hemmed.

Dimensions

c. 60" W x 72 1/2" L (hemmed)

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
