Lliqlla (llicla), also called a manta in Spanish, that serves as a warm shoulder cloth but may also serve as a carrier for a baby or goods. Two panels stitched together decoratively. Primarily maroon warp with narrow stripes in brown, green, orange, yellow, pink. Decorative tubing on all four edges.
