## Ch'uspa (Coca Bag)

Handspun alpaca and sheep wool

**Description**  
Ch'uspa or wayaka bag with figurative (horses and birds with outstretched wings) and geometric designs on striped field. Geometrics include rayed diamonds representing Inti, the Sun God. One external pocket on one side. The bag has no strap; it was folded over when used.
