


# Basic Detail Report

## Bow Drill

Leather/Hide, walrus ivory

**Description**

Bow drill made from walrus ivory with holes at the ends for the attachment of a leather thong. Undecorated but nicely shaped. Part of a drill kit (igauquk) that also included a drill stick (A7), base (A8), and mouthpiece (A9).
